## East Ohio Camps

The East Ohio Conference of the United Methodist Church  
Rate Schedule for Outdoor Education  
Effective January 2022-December 2023\*\*

Outdoor Education is defined as school groups in grades 12 and under that use Camp Asbury's lodging facilities and meal service between 4:00 pm on Sunday and 4:00 pm on Friday. Retreat rates will be charged for school groups using camp facilities between 4:00 pm on Friday and 4:00 pm on Sunday. ### Outdoor Education Rates for Camp Asbury:

A non-refundable/non-transferable deposit of \$350.00 is required. The rates for groups staying in any Camp Asbury lodging facility, meal service included are as follows:

| <u># of People</u> | <u>Age</u>      | <u>Rate</u>   |
|--------------------|-----------------|---|
| 20 or less         | Grades 1-Adult: | \$50.00 per person, per 24 hour period for lodging and three meals. |
| 21 – 50            | Grades 1-Adult: | \$47.00 per person, per 24 hour period for lodging and three meals. |
| 51 – 80            | Grades 1-Adult: | \$43.00 per person, per 24 hour period for lodging and three meals. |
| 81 and up          | Grades 1-Adult: | \$41.00 per person, per 24 hour period for lodging and three meals. |

For groups staying in Epworth Retreat Center who prepare their own food:  
Grades 1-Adult: \$30.00 per person, per 24 hour period. \$350 deposit required.

Per person meal rates for those adults attending as daytime guests are as follows:

**\*In order to assure staff availability, reservations for ropes courses or climbing tower must be made one month in advance. Use of climbing tower may be incorporated into a high ropes session at no additional charge.**

**Groups using only low ropes, high ropes, high ropes or climbing tower, but not utilizing overnight accommodations at Camp Asbury, will be charged a per person day-use fee in addition to the programming fee.**

**NOTE: All aquatic activities (swimming, canoeing, boating) require that a lifeguard certified by the American Red Cross or equivalent and approved by Camp Asbury director be present. Lifeguards must present original certification upon arrival. If a Camp Asbury lifeguard is not available, groups are responsible for providing and compensating their own lifeguard with the prior approval of the camp director.**

### Cleaning and Repairs

Groups will be charged an additional \$20 per hour for cleaning services for facilities which require additional attention from use beyond normal "wear and tear". Groups will be charged for damages to facilities and equipment based on actual costs of repair or replacement.
